**RE: Jackson Area Improvement Project  
New Concrete & Temporary Loss of Driveway Access 03 (Madison St)**

Dear Resident:

Construction of the Jackson Area Improvement Project has reached the point where the installation of new concrete on Madison Street is ready to begin. This work includes partial curb and public sidewalk replacement, and any existing concrete driveway aprons. Framing is expected to begin Monday, May 12, with pouring expected to begin later in the week. This work will take approximately 7 to 10 days to complete, weather and other circumstances permitting. **You will lose access to your driveway during the entire period this work takes place; you will not have overnight access.**

**Please make arrangements to have all necessary vehicles out of your driveway by 6:00 A.M. on Monday, May 12, 2025.**

Residents are encouraged to remove any necessary vehicles from their driveways by 6:00 a.m., Monday, May 12, and park them on adjacent side streets. Residents are allowed to continue parking overnight on adjacent side streets, where usually permitted.

We recognize that this work will be some of the most inconvenient and frustrating for residents, however once the concrete is properly cured, street and driveway access should return to relatively normal until the project is complete. During this time:

- Residents will not have any access to their driveways for approximately 7 to 10 days, beginning Monday, May 12, 2025. Weather or other circumstances may extend this timeframe.
- Residents are asked to park outside of active work areas during the day where parking is normally permitted. Areas zoned as "No Parking" still apply. Do not park outside Village limits, as typical parking restrictions for the Village of Lombard still apply.
- Residents that require special accommodation should contact the public works department so that we can accommodate as best as possible.
- The Villa Park Police Department will be notified of the need for this parking situation and should accommodate residents accordingly. You do not need to register with the police department to park on the street overnight.
