RE: Twin Lakes Area Street Improvement Program

Dear Resident:

Construction of the **Twin Lakes Area Street Improvement Program** is expected to begin August 17, 2015. A number of preliminary construction efforts, including survey layout and staking, locating of underground utilities, installation of traffic control, and mobilization of materials and equipment will need to be completed before full construction operations are able to begin. These preliminary efforts should take approximately a week to complete, and full construction operations will follow.

This project consists of full depth reclamation of Yale Avenue and Belden Avenue and patching and resurfacing of the other roadway surfaces. Traffic on the streets within the project limits will be affected by construction efforts. There may be a need for temporary road closures throughout the project as equipment or materials move in and out of the site. Access to properties' driveways may also be restricted for periods of time while work is taking place in front of those particular properties. Residents will have access to their driveways overnight throughout most of the project. Rest assured, we will work with residents to keep them informed of any planned work efforts which may cause additional inconvenience. No parking will be allowed on the streets during the day as construction is taking place. Please follow all posted signs.
